Members of the Great Meeting Chapel - No charge for any Rite of Passage ceremonies. Donations welcome.

The "Steward" fee will be payable to the person in charge of opening and closing the chapel on the day of the ceremony, ensuring that the building and grounds are presentable and free from potential hazards on the day of the ceremony, and providing guests with assistance.

In exceptional circumstances the minister, in consultation with the chair of the congregation, can reduce or waive the chapel hire fees.
